

Newly Signed Technical Exchange Agreement with Guangzhou Water Investment Group Co., Ltd. China

CTIE signed a Technical Exchange Agreement with Guangzhou Water Investment Group Co., Ltd. on 5th November 2009 in Guangzhou, China. Guangzhou City has become one of the most developed cities in China in the recent years. With the Asian Games to be held there in October 2010, the city is rushing to complete construction on thousands of related infrastructure projects. Guangzhou Water Investment Group Co., Ltd. has complete authority and responsibility for planning, construction, maintenance and operation of portable water, sewerage, and management of local rivers and channels in Guangzhou City.

The agreement provides for an exchange of technical information on water environmental issues, including water purification and inundation prevention, mutual visits and dispatches of each personnel. CTIE will contribute to these activities through its consulting services. It is anticipated that the agreement will lead to an acceleration of technical exchanges between the two parties and further development of CTIE business activity in Guangzhou and in southern China.

Prior to the signing ceremony a technical exchange seminar was held, in which 7 persons from Japan and more than 20 from China participated. In the seminar reports were delivered by representatives from Guangzhou side on the current portable water supply-demand situation, the sewage treatment situation, and ongoing construction projects. This was followed by comments from CTIE participants, who shared their experiences and expertise in the field of inundation prevention in urban areas and water purification. The seminar concluded with a spirited question-and-answer session involving all the participants.
